## 2. Recently held and planned Workshops for Trainees

## 3. **Upcoming Activities**

CPD Exec Team: on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017, Chris Bray took over the lead on CPD, relinquishing his position as Chair of the RTPA – Will Burns now leads the RTPA. Graham Tomkinson will continue with CPD.

CPD Marking level 3 Assess: Assessments of M Seigneur / J Smith are being planned for April 2017 – this will need suitable matches for them to mark.

CPD Management Level 3: plans exist for the assessment of W Burns (2017) / K Ludekens (later in the year?). Their Chairmen are in full support. Other Head Professionals: discussions taking place with them and their Chairs regarding their attendance at Level 3 Training workshops in 2017 and assessment some 6 months after. All work in this area is led by Graham Tomkinson.

CPD 1 Assess: Assessment of the 4 current trainees (B Bomford (12/4/17), A Flippence (22/3/17), S Kashdan (12/4/17), Merola (12/4/17)) for CPD Level 1 skills levels. They will be held at Wellington. Facilities have been confirmed / assessors/ those being assessed / their head professionals were notified in November 2016. Trainees were advised of the necessary pass level standards during their training workshops last year. Assessors are D Jones (Coaching), D Lyons (Marking), S Ronaldson (Equipment), G Tomkinson (General matters/exam). Assessment is being led by Chris Bray and Graham Tomkinson. Pass/fail plus short report will be sent to attendees (copy their head professionals) within seven days of their assessments.

CPD Coaching level 2 being revamped - to be announced and delivered - about 15 professionals to attend (e.g. 3 x 5 per session) – Likely start date for delivery is circa May 2017. The revamped level 2 will consist of a day training on how people learn (pedagogy), using on and off court programmes – this has been designed by Professor Susan Capel with staff work by Alex Lucas and Dan Jones. The second day of training will be Biomechanics followed by assessments for off and on court skills by Alex Lucas and Dan Jones respectively. Good progress is being made on this.

Chris Bray will contact Z Eadle, J Brodie, L Gordon and J Ryan's re their career development skills programmes. Chris is also reviewing CPD Equipment level 2.
